Ministry reports

Altar Servers: Fr. Ken trained all school 4th & 5th graders. He & Pete Haack will work on training RE students.

Extraordinary Ministers: Karen Bishop, nothing new

Hospitality/ Cross Bearers: Dana Bastian did train another family for greeters/ushers. The name tag box has been cleaned out and all current active greeters are made and are in the box. It was discussed whether sacristans should wear something so they are easily identified. Fr. Ken would like a ministries' board made for the narthex that could hang by the TV. There would be magnetic tiles that would post the positions that we still need filled for Mass.

Lector/Commentators: Mike Otis

Communications: Kyle Curran & Gary Olson - absent

Music & environment: Cari Higgins – talked about how nice the new altar linens look and upcoming Mass times (see below). Will hope to have an anointing of the sick during a Mass before Advent.

Discussion Items-

- Deacon Fred had a document that explains the Liturgy as described in the *Sacrosanctum Concilium*. A thorough discussion took place on how our different ministries can show reverence during Mass.
- Here are a few observations that could be changed & the above ministry leaders can let their volunteers know:

Bowing – all come to altar, bow at the center point

Ministers not showing up – always a challenge to find subs before Mass; are substitutes trained?

Cross bearers – walking way too fast/please wait until singing begins; need to just bow head and not at waist; immediately put cross in stand

Book bearer – in the procession: place the Book of Gospels in the stand on the altar from the front of altar; show reverence for Book of Gospels; simple bow keeping book upright

Altar servers – simple bow keeping candles upright; always walk in front of altar and do not need to bow each time; synchronize movements for gospel & setting altar **Lector** – Proclaim only what is in the Lectionary (do not say "The first reading is...." Or "The second reading is...." Handle the Lectionary or Book of Gospel with reverence; bow at front of altar

Cantor/s – Option of walking to in front of the altar, bow & walk up steps or continue to bow at side and walk up ramp; please leave mic off during practice and let rosary know to start 20 min before Mass & that you will turn mic on for that; do not leave ambo too quickly after done singing (wait for piano to end); be mindful of conversations that they are not during the rosary or too loud **Commentator** – bow to the front of altar; be at the ambo for the priest's introduction to the petitions (Leave the pew at the creed's "One, Holy Catholic, Apostolic church"), REMAIN at ambo until the priest has concluded the closing prayer

Ministers of Holy Communion – it would look nice if they approached the altar and waited for all & bow together

Right to Life Month -

Oct. 5/6 Masses - kick off to Right to Life Month – children invited to process in with Fr. Ken and he will bless them. Father Ken will have his bulletin letter be about life.

Oct. 6 Pet blessing, Sunday, 2 PM (St. Francis day was Oct. 4)

Nov. 1 All Saints Day - Friday, 12:00 PM, 6:30 PM Mass

Dec. 8 – Immaculate Conception. This is a Saturday, so normal weekend readings. Christmas Masses will be Tuesday, Dec. 24 at 4:00 PM (2 Masses at this time; Fr. Larry in gym), 6:30 PM & 10:00 PM. Christmas Day, 9:00 AM
