The group expressed a desire to keep our relationship going. Christine will check with them to see if they expect to do on-site packing events this fall and if so will check with parish/school staff if we can host.
Family Promise is not being held at OLIH during the pandemic, an evening host is till needed on August $11^{\text {th }}$.
Patsy shared a new project that has started to sew bags from used t-shirts to be used by the guests at the Food Bank to take their groceries home in. They are easier to use and the Food Bank can buy fewer boxes. She found out that the church does not allow dropoffs in the Narthex due to COVID-19
Patsy and Paul are facilitating an 8 week Just Faith course on Racial Equity that began on July $27^{\text {th }}$. There are 11 participants and is being held via ZOOM.
