Habitat for Humanity

St. Luke's is participating in the Catholic Circle of Faith to sponsor another Humanity House build. Four houses are being built on the same block in Des Moines. St. Luke's was assigned two dates for volunteers, September 7 and October 26. Paul has submitted information for the bulletin and weekly newsletter and included the Sign-Up Genius and another link with information explaining steps the homebuyers go through to purchase a Habitat house. St. Luke's Prime Timers have volunteered to provide lunch for all the workers on October 26.
