C. New Business

a. Church Gym Rental

- i. With the Wedding Policy set, few parishioners to asked us to reconsider the price to rent the gym such as after a Baptism or some local family event. We were asked to consider per hour and not one price to fit all occasions. Right now, the price is \$150 up to 4 hours; currently deposit is \$300 with a \$150 refund following the event.
- ii. Renters should set up and clean up.
- iii. 2 hrs and 4 hrs is suggested as 1 hr. won't cover setting up and taking down tables
- iv. Certain prices for certain events: baptism, family events. Keep a higher rate for sporting events to meet Ankeny demand. If the rate is too high, parishioners won't rent it.
- v. Safe serve certification would prevent allowing kitchen use during rentals. (Ask Angela, DMAAC 4-6 hrs with a test). It's required since the kitchen is used to serve the school kids.
- vi. Ask Knights about safe serve certification
- vii. Fees should go into a fund that goes towards eventually replacing tables, kitchen items, etc.
- viii. Formal policy should be draft.
 - 1. Dana will ask Kendra for some data on how often the gym is rented. Confirm current basketball/sporting events.
