Committee Updates

Welcome Committee: advent TTT calls removed many people listed as parishioners. More were removed when diocese did some record keeping clean up. Will clean up more with calls and have more reliability. For calls – people give us permission to be

able to call them. This information was looked up for the donut team for people who gave permission, took dana three days to pull data; parish soft is what we use; Vicki's list vs Dana list, required by diocese to use.

Social Concerns – A meal was prepared for the Catholic Worker House on Saturday, January 23. The next one is scheduled for February 27. In addition, a member of the committee invited parishioners via Sign-Up Genius to donate other items always in need at the Catholic Worker House to her home on February 5, and she had an SUV filled and delivered that day. Items requested: new or used blankets, adult winter outerwear, hand warmers, toilet paper, bulk plastic forks. A meal was prepared and an overnight host provided for one night of Family Promise (Jan 26), in partnership with OLIH (as they host for the entire week). Two items are in the works for a Lenten service project and a virtual prayer/study opportunity. Details are still in the works and approval needed on the prayer/study opportunity.
