- Back to Church Update
 - Reaching out to parishioners Results~ <500 families contacted (voicemail, email, phone calls)
 - updated database; many people pleased with phone call (only those who gave permission to call were called)
 - 80 prayer intentions shared
 - Mass numbers continue to increase
 - gym will remain available (some families prefer that option to spread out)
- Parish Online Directory~ Shani and Brian will continue to work through it
 - Finance and School Board will try next
- Capital Campaign Update
 - o back on list for "Legacy" Grant from Prairie Meadows (\$400,000)~ announcement Mid/End of May
 - o pledges are continuing to come in
 - o borrow from emergency fund and use line of credit to finish out

 - o CGS (Catechesis of the Good Shepard)~ available starting next year potentially
 - O Vacation Bible School is back this year June 7th-June 11th
 - limited capacity~ filling up
 - donations and volunteers have started too

Committee Updates

- Welcome Committee~ 6 new registrations with 17 new family members ~680 total
 - o number dropped due to 'clean up' of registrants
- Social Concerns~
 - 160 Easter cards collected and delivered to 3 area resident communities during Holy Week
 - Catholic Worker House meals are continuing as well
 - o 40 cans for Lent with Knights went well also
- Liturgy
 - o training for Altar servers with school kids and after mass during April 24th
 - o Palm Sunday~ well attended
 - Holy Week and Easter masses very well attended
 - o Fr. Larry 50th anniversary of ordination celebration August 8th

Father Ken's comments

- School, Building Project
 - interior framing almost done, walls are coming next
 - o classrooms are large and increasing overall storage capacity as well
 - o 265 enrolled for 2021 (budgeted for 255)

- o all but 10 current kids already registered~ predicting 270
- o new teacher interviews ongoing
- assistance from Knights to help with wiring new building
- o additional freezer will be purchased for Knights/other usage
- Temporary buildings
 - music room?
 - may need to apply for another 2 years
 - not enough space for 2 classes of 7th and 8th grade
- Budget updates
 - o Finance Council will wrap up Parish Budget next week (only 5% down in tithing)
 - Loan refinancing~ lower % interest
- Green Gala
 - Casual and other changes
 - waiting for update from Joe Schmidtlein
 - o potential new name/branding
 - o June 19th
- Purchasing large tent?
 - o if multiple groups are using them, is it better to purchase?
- Parish Picnic Open House for building
 - August
- Selling Bricks Fundraiser
 - o outside courtyard~ near the front door
 - o \$19 cost with \$100 donation
- South Parking Lot
 - o landscaping will need volunteers late spring
- North sidewalk deal being negotiated to lower
- Property North and West of us
 - ATI~ rezoned to townhouses and single family homes
 - up to 18th St. additional townhouses
