## Capital Campaign Update

- St. Luke's is in the last phase of the launch of the diocesan capital campaign Oxtoberfest Update
  - Net Profit: \$11,124.08
  - Consideration is being given to shortening the festival for next year secondary to volunteer availability and waning attendance later in the event
    - Possibly shift 5k to the parish picnic, possibly have either a day event prior to mass or shift it to an evening event after mass
    - Buying tickets for food/drink went well for families
    - Consider having all events inside next year to reduce risk of inclement weather
  - Funds have been set aside for vestments
  - Searching for Oxtoberfest Chairmembers typically Parish Council members fill
  - Handbid annual membership half paid from Gala budget, half paid from Oxtoberfest budget
