Capital Campaign Update

- December went well with a few large pledges coming in during the month
- Ignite (Diocese Campaign)
 - *\$625,000 is SLTE's goal*
 - SLTE is part of Phase 3 of the launch with planned start date in Fall 2022
 - Funds will support an endowment for Catholic Schools in the Diocese - SLTE does not currently have an endowment so this will directly benefit SLTE
 - If SLTE raises more than the goal, SLTE will receive >90% of the surplus funds raised
- Phase III of SLTE Campaign will commence after the conclusion of the Ignite Campaign

Committee Updates

Welcome Committee

- 106 new registered families in 2021 (300 new family members)
- 757 total parish families Social Concerns
- Collected 50 coats in Winter coat collection
- For Lent, planning to support Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl

Liturgy

- ~900-1000 people at 4pm Masses alone on Christmas Eve
- ~300 people at 6pm on Christmas Eve
- ~200 people at 10pm on Christmas Eve
- ~200 people on Christmas Day
- Overall weekend mass attendance has been good
- People have stepped up to assist with counting collection money after mass

Finance (Prayer Garden—Brick Campaign)

- December \$10,000 donation received for new monstrance
- Brick Campaign ~\$40,000-\$50,000 in profit
 - Profit will be used for the short fall for new building

Other

- Judy Jones has stepped down from the council
- School Zone on Weigel Dr. Update
 - City has said the school does not have enough children within 0.5 mile to justify the creation of a crosswalk on Weigel
 - School has been in discussion with the city regarding different options to ensure student's safety crossing the street, but city has not approved any resolutions
- AED training for Parish Council at next meeting

Father Ken's comments

School

- School budget has been set 4% raise to all salaries, additional 2% raise to returning staff
- Budgeting for 300 kids next year challenge goal is to reach 310 kids of total enrollment for next year

Building Project

- Heat went out in new conference room, but has now been fixed
- Heat has been an issue in some of the classrooms but this has been resolved
